Next-generation Vietnamese and American leaders in academia, government, civil society and business/industry, between the age of 22 and 35, are invited to submit paper proposals on any aspects of US-Vietnam relations.

Six to eight selected authors will be mentored by Pacific Forum's senior staff over the course of six months. Authors of the top four papers will present at a virtual dialogue in March 2021, commemorating the 25 years of US-Vietnam relations.

Final drafts of all papers will be published in a special edition of Pacific Forum's Issues & Insights series. A modest honorarium will be provided to all selected authors, who will also have opportunities to attend future conferences and workshops related to US-Vietnam relations, sponsored by Pacific Forum.

HOW TO APPLY

Please submit an abstract
of no more than 300 words
describing the US and/or Vietnamese
perspective on the relationship over the
past 25 years. You may choose to offer a
broad assessment of the topic (including new
challenges in US-Vietnam relations and policy
recommendations) or focus on a specific facet of
the relationship (e.g., maritime security, transitional
justice/reconciliation/people-to-people ties, economy
and trade, defense cooperation).

Selected authors will have to submit the first draft of full papers (4,000-7,000 words) by January 25, 2021.
